last night."

Examples

I was at my Gran's house
yesterday.
You were late for school
this morning.

Remember!

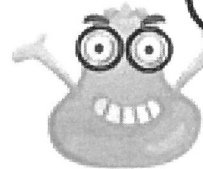
I was

He was
It was
We were
They were

Be careful!

For negatives add 'n't' or
'not'.
*I wasn't late for school this
morning.*
*We were not tired
yesterday.*

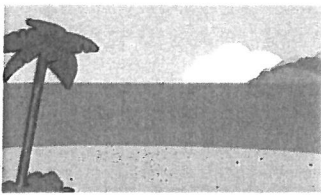

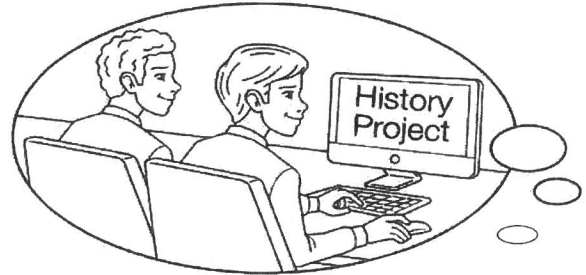
