Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I like	I don't like	Do I like...?
You like	You don't like	Do you like...?
He/she/it likes	He/she/it doesn't like	Does he/she/it like...?
We like	We don't like	Do we like...?
You like	You don't like	Do you like...?
They like	They don't like	Do they like...?

3^a PERSONA

Añadimos -s	Añadimos -es cuando el verbo acaba en: -sh,-ch,-ss or -o.	Añadimos -ies cuando el verbo acaba en consonant + -y
walk → walks love → loves	wash → washes watch → watches kiss → kisses go → goes	study → studies carry → carries

PRESENTE CONTINUO

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I am studying	I am not studying	Am I studying?
You are studying	You aren't studying	Are you studying?
He /she / it is studying	He / she / it isn't studying	Is he / she / it studying?
We are studying	We aren't studying	Are we studying?
You are studying	You aren't studying	Are you studying?
They are studying	They aren't studying	Are they studying?

PASADO SIMPLE

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I was	I wasn't	Was I?
You were	You weren't	Were you?
He/she/it was	He/she/it wasn't	Was he/she/it?
We were	We weren't	Were we?
You were	You weren't	Were you?
They were	They weren't	Were they?

ADJETIVOS SUPERLATIVOS CUYA ESTRUCTURA ES: THE + ADJETIVO + -EST

Ajetivos de 1 sílaba	Sólo tenemos que añadir -est al adjetivo. TALL – THE TALLEST
Ajetivos de 1 sílaba que acaban en vocal más consonante.	Tenemos que doblar la consonante y añadir -est . BIG – THE BIGGEST

Adjetivos de 1 sílaba que acaban en -e	Sólo tenemos que añadir al adjetivo -st LARGE – THE LARGEST
Adjetivos de 2 sílabas que acaban en -y	Cambiamos la -Y por -I ; y añadimos -est HAPPY - HAPPIEST

Usamos la estructura: **the most + adjective** con.

En la mayoría de los adjetivos de 2 sílabas, la forma es:	Pleasant = the most pleasant
Los adjetivos de 3 o más sílabas, la forma es:	Intelligent = the most intelligent

Pero... tenemos excepciones:

GOOD	THE BEST
BAD	THE WORST
FAR	THE FURTHEST
LITTLE	THE LEAST
