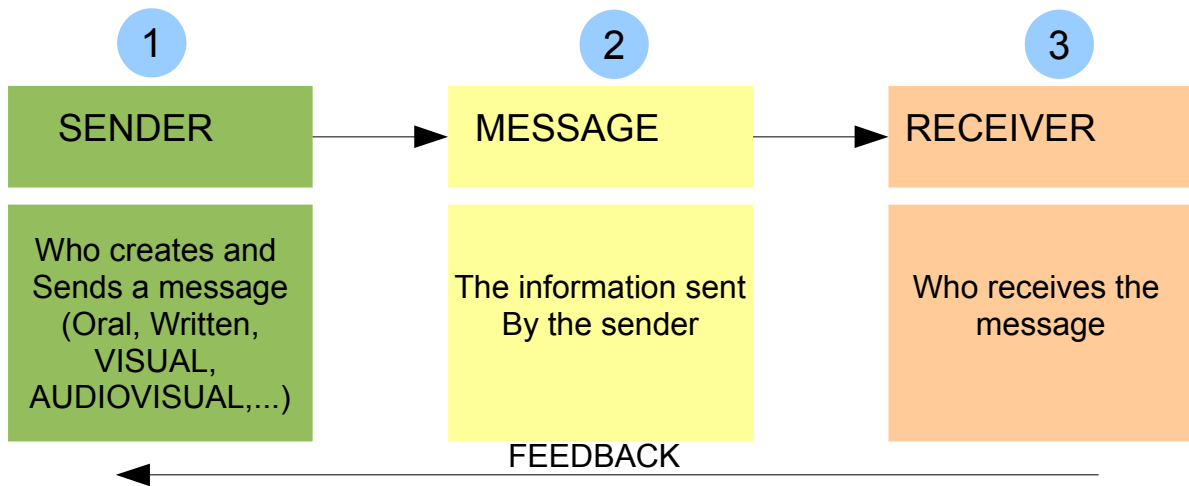


# 1 VISUAL COMMUNICATION

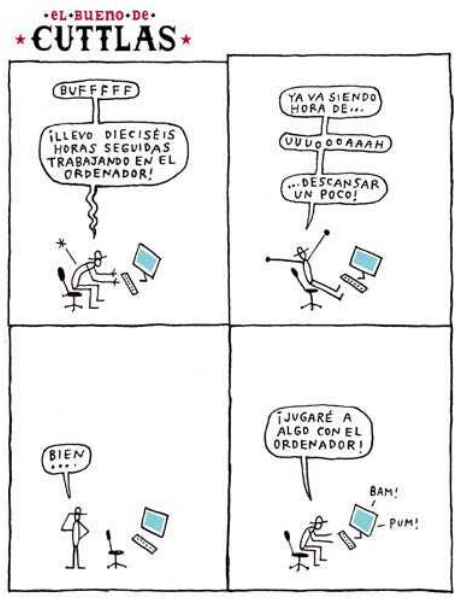
## 1(1) ELEMENTS OF THE COMMUNICATION PROCESS



- 4 **CODE (LANGUAGE)** The group of preset signs and rules that are known by the sender and the receiver in order to encode and decode messages
- 5 **CHANNEL** Is the means used to transmit the message. e.g.: voice (radio), text(book, e-book...), art graphic technics (drawing, painting,...), audiovisuals (cinema, video,...), etc
- 6 **CONTEXT** Environmental conditions (place, moment, social environment, etc) in which the communication is done ( so, the same message could have different interpretations in different contexts)
- 7 **NOISE** Calquera interferencia no canal que dificulta a comunicación.
- 8 **FEEDBACK** Information back from the receiver

## 2 (1) THE VISUAL COMMUNICATION.

The visual communication is the process of communication made through images. Images can transmit (convey) messages by themselves or combined with words, sounds, etc.



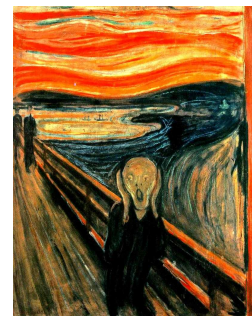
### 3 (1) THE PURPOSE OF THE IMAGES

As a communication is established, the sender has always a main purpose and, depending on it, the images can be classified in four groups:

informative	The purpose is to describe something (an object, a situation, etc.)
exhortative	The communication is intended to suggest, order, recommend, convince ...
expressive	The sender wants express personal feelings
aesthetic	The sender looks for beauty by itself

Usually we can find more than one purpose on the images but one of them is going to be the most important. For instance, a photographer can take a picture to illustrate a piece of news in a magazine and, at the same time, try to express some feelings. To know what is the main purpose of an example of visual communication, we must ask ourselves: **what is the image made for?**

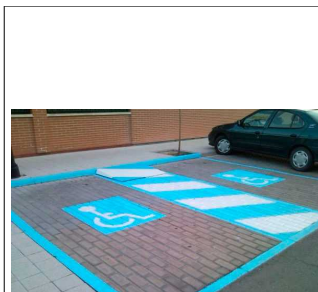

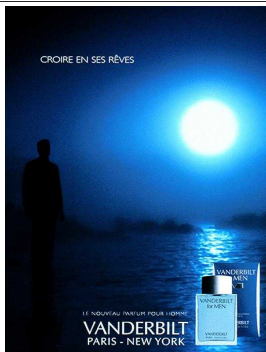
