Modal Perfects	Uses	Examples
could have	Ability to do something in the past, but which wasn't done in the end	<i>The children were tired. They</i> could have stopped to rest. (Los niños estaban cansados. Podrían haber parado a descansar.)
can't / couldn't have	Certainty that something didn't happen	Pam can't / couldn't have performed at the concert. She was ill. (Pam no puede / pudo haber tocado en el concierto. Estaba enferma.)
may / might have	A guess about a past action	<i>He may / might have lost the tickets.</i> (Puede que haya perdido las entradas.)
must have	Certainty or logical conclusion about an event in the past	It must have been exciting for her to perform in front of thousands of people. (Tiene que haber sido emocionante para ella tocar delante de miles de personas.)
should / ought to have	Criticism or regret after an event	You should / ought to have taken a taxi to go to the concert. (Deberías haber cogido un taxi para ir al concierto.)
shouldn't have	Criticism or regret after an event	<i>We shouldn't have come by car.</i> (No deberíamos haber venido en coche.)
would have	Willingness or desire to do something, but which wasn't actually done	<i>They would have held the concert outside but it was raining.</i> (Habrían celebrado el concierto al aire libre pero estaba lloviendo.)

Usos

could have + participio

Indica que se pudo haber hecho algo en el pasado pero que finalmente no se hizo.

can't have / couldn't have + participio

Expresa la certeza de que algo no pudo haber ocurrido.

may / might have + participio

Se usan para hacer una suposición de un hecho pasado.

must have + participio

Expresa una conclusión lógica de un hecho pasado.

should / ought to have + participio

Con ambos podemos tanto quejarnos de lo que ocurrió como lamentarnos de que no se haya cumplido lo que esperábamos.

shouldn't have + participio

Expresa nuestra opinión crítica sobre un hecho pasado, indicando que no debería haber ocurrido.

would have + participio

Indica que se quiso haber hecho algo en el pasado pero no se pudo debido a factores o circunstancias externas.
