STEPS TO DO YOUR TASK (PASOS PARA FACER A TAREFA)

4. Do you remember when we have illustrated a poem by Rosalía de Castro? You can do something similar, but you have to keep in mind that CARVALHO'S POEM is different. Read it carefully, and try to imagine the meaning of the poem and draw something creative about it.
