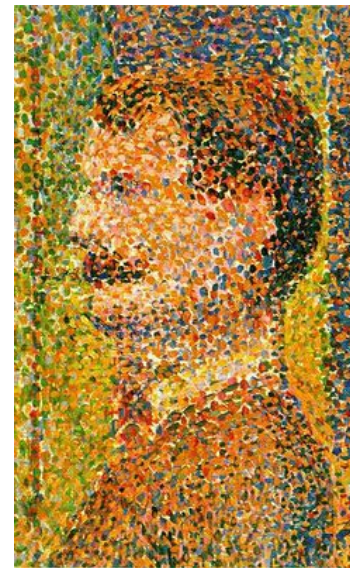
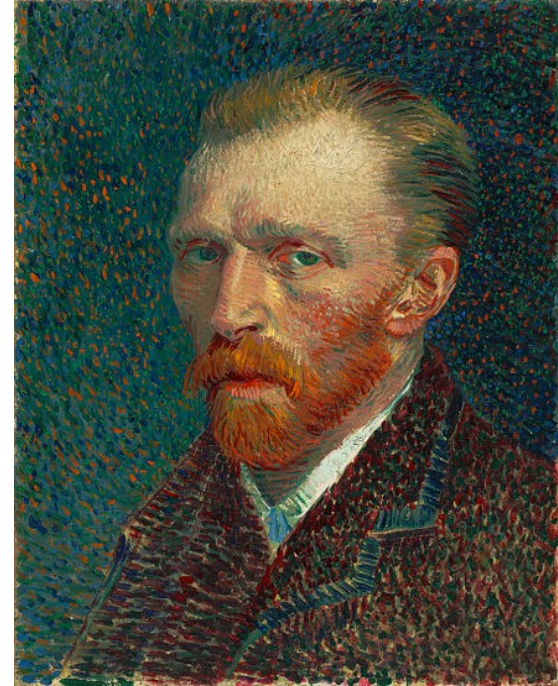


Pointillism



Technique

- Pointillism is a brush technique used in painting.
- It blends spots of colour to make a fuller range of tones.
- To do it you must use the brush to make small dots.
- You must only use pure colours.



History

- Pointillism was a revolutionary painting technique started by Georges Seurat and Paul Signac.
- It was started in Paris in the mid-1880s.
- The idea is that you use unmixed colours that would be blended by the viewer's eye.
- You must not use long brush strokes.
- Pointillism is a Neo-Impressionist movement.
