Do you love animals? Then this is the perfect holiday for you! The Galapagos Islands are an archipelago in the Pacific Ocean. The islands are home to many unusual animals.

Come and see **green sea turtles**. They live in the water around the Galapagos Islands. They've got green skin and a brown shell. They can swim up to 55 km an hour! Turtles lay eggs in the sand on the beach. Two months later, the eggs hatch. The journey from the egg to the sea is very dangerous for the baby turtles. There are many birds waiting to catch and eat them.

You can see **marine iguanas** on all of the Galapagos Islands. You can't see them in any other place in the world. Most marine iguanas are brown, black and grey. Some have got patches of red and blue. They live on the rocks and in the water. They can swim underwater for up to 30 minutes.

Many of the animals on the Galapagos Islands are endangered. You can have a wonderful holiday on the islands, but all tourists must respect the animals and their habitat. There are some wonderful hotels on the islands. You can also stay on a boat. The boats take you from island to island to see all the different animals.
