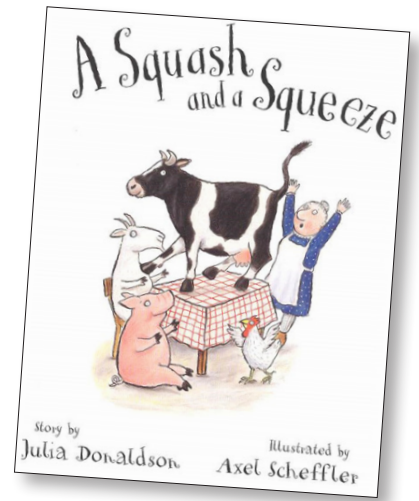


# A Squash and a Squeeze
