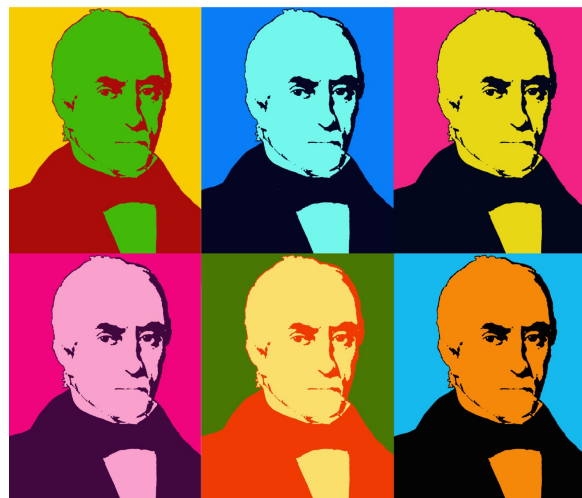
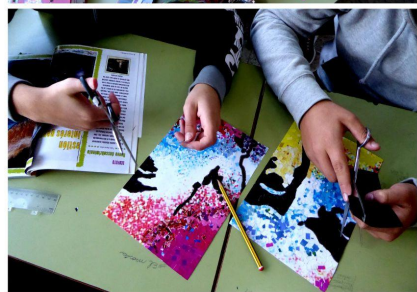
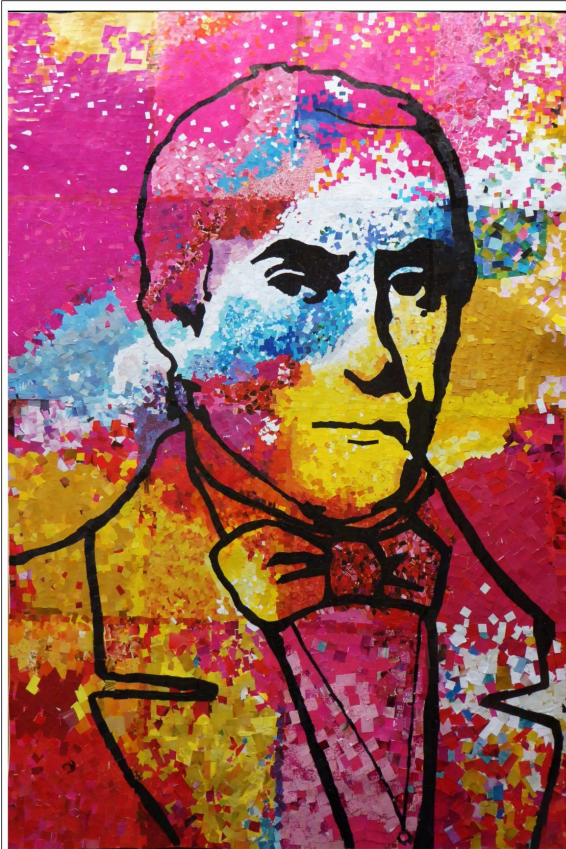


Geometric map of GALICIA

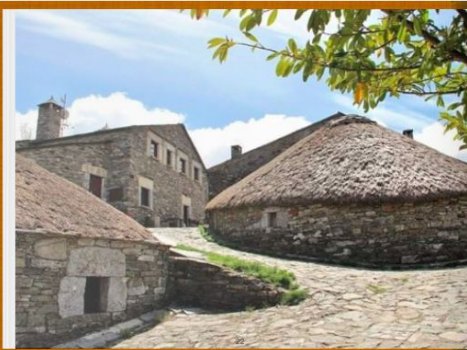
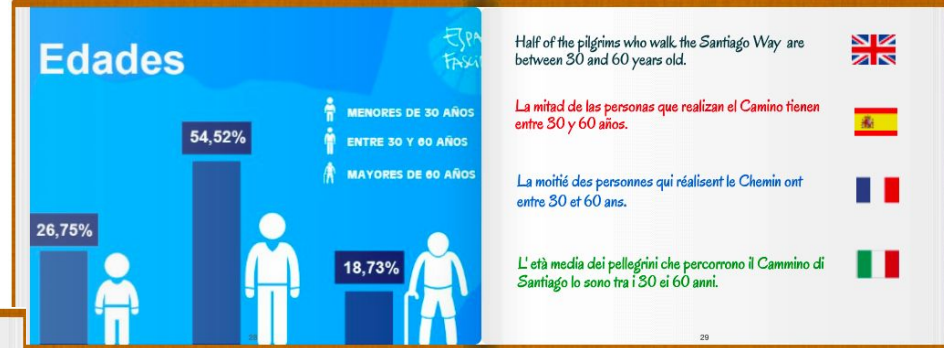
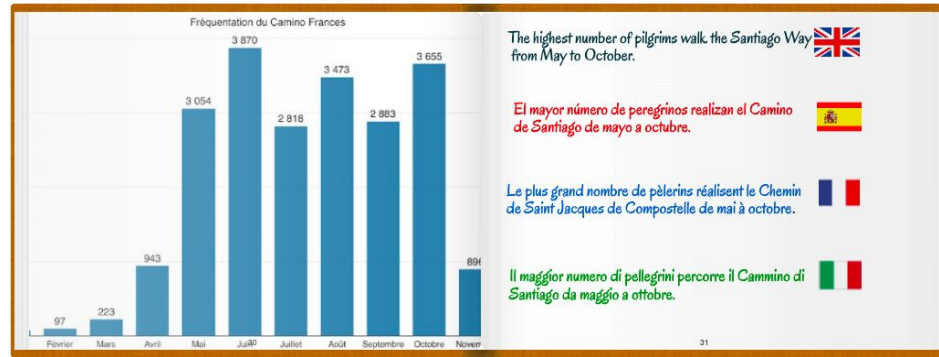
Croce di Giarosetta

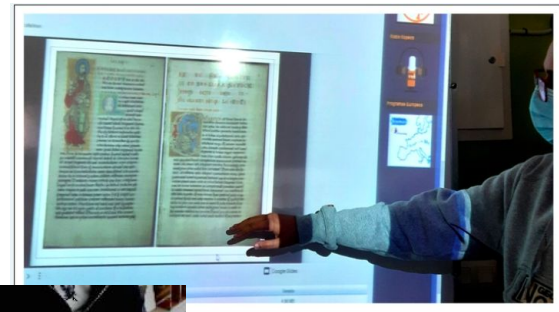

Come to Portas!

Where is Portas?
 Portas is a small village near Caldas de Reis, in Pontevedra, Galicia. It has an area of 22 squares kilometers and a had 2.996 inhabitants in 2020.

A little bit of its history:
 In Portas was born Domingo Fontán Rodríguez. He started to make the first topographic and science map of Galicia in the year 1817 and he finished it in 1838.

Now he's buried in the Parthenon de Gallegos houses, in Santiago de Compostela.

Places to eat:
 In Portas there are several bars and restaurants, these ones are best ones:
O RECLINCHO DO CHADO: All their food is handmade. The best dishes are:
 The cod of the Portuguese and the salsapas for the fish. It's a very typical Galician dish.

PIZZA SHOP HENAR:
 This bar is just next to the pilgrim's hostel. They make the best pizzas of Portas.

Where to stay:
 In Brilios there is a pilgrims' hostel. It's in the Pontevedra-Portas. It's in the Caldeirón de San Xosé, in the Portuguese way. One night cost 8 euros. It's only for pilgrims. It opens from 13:00 to 22:00. It has a capacity for 27 persons, in 13 rooms. It has 7 WCs and 4 showers.

There's a river near and the price always cheaper. It's just next to the hostel. There's a nice garden with a park in front of the hostel. The bar use to be a terrace, too.

Landmarks:
THE OLD SUGAR FACTORY:
 It's an old sugar factory rehabilitated. Inside there's an auditorium, a kindergarten and a residence for the elderly. Its chimney is the most scenic part. It chimney is 60 metres tall and it's the best viewpoint of the Gallego region.

THE TOWER OF THE LAMAS:
 This tower is near to the pilgrim's hostel. It's so good for refresh your feet after a long day walking.

Advice:
 If you are going to come to Galicia you should bring an umbrella, because here rains a lot -except in summer- some should bring some T-shirts, some trousers and a sweater or a hoodie, because in the morning and at the night it's cold.

The best season to come is in winter, because it's too cold for walk in a long distance and it rains a lot. In April it rains a lot too, but it's colder than in winter.

The best season to come is in spring. The trees are in bloom and all in green. May is the best month to come.

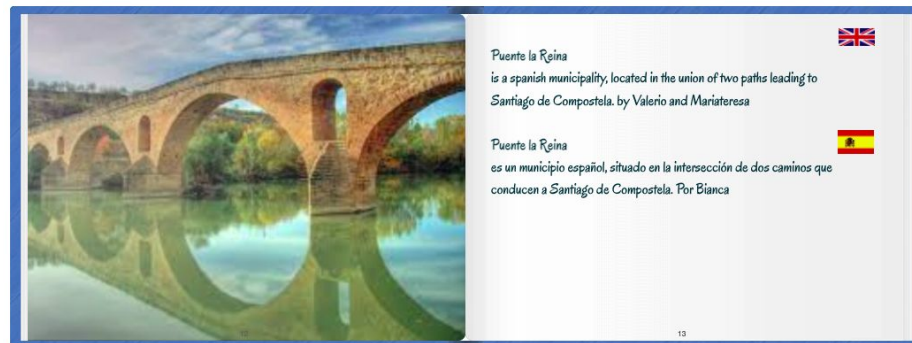
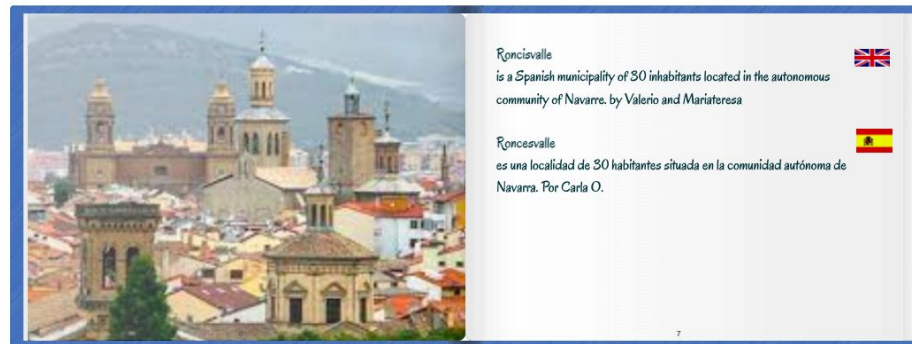

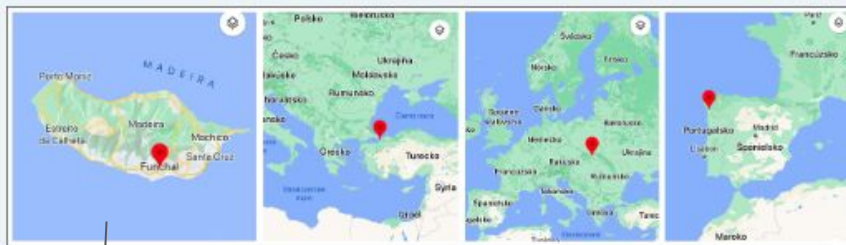
