

1. REWRITE THE FOLLOWING SENTENCES USING **MODAL VERBS**.

- *It's prohibited / it's forbidden* to stick posters.

You...CAN'T stick posters

- *I'm certain/ I'm sure* she is in London.

She ...MUST be in London.

- *It's not necessary* to bring cakes.

You...NEEDN'T bring

- *It was not necessary* to bring cakes.

You ...NEEDN'T HAVE brought.

- *It's not an obligation* to go.

You...NEEDN'T go

- *It was not an obligation* for her to do the work.

She...DIDN'T HAVE TO do

- *It's not an obligation* to enter/ *You are not obliged* to enter.

You...needn't enter

- *I'm certain/I'm sure* that Joe **is lying**.

Joe...MUST be lying

- *It's prohibited* to smoke in this area.

You ...CAN'T smoke.....

- *It's important* that you listen carefully.

You ...MUST listen carefully

- *I'm sure* he **isn't working**.

He ...CAN'T BE WORKING

- *It's not necessary* for her to wear elegant clothes

She...NEEDN'T wear

- She wasn't able to* speak French at the age of 7.

She...COULDN'T speak

- I'm sure* that she **went** to London.

She ...MUST HAVE GONE.....

- Perhaps* he **left** the shop.

He ...MAY/MIGHT/COULD HAVE LEFT.....

- It's impossible* that he **bought** that car.

He ...CAN'T HAVE BOUGHT.....

17. *It's a pity* you **didn't phone!**

You...SHOULD HAVE PHONED

18. *It's possible* that Eva is ill

Eva...MIGHT/MAY/COULD BE

19. *There's a possibility* that they will pass the exams.

They...MAY/MIGHT/COULD PASS.....

20. *It's a pity* you didn't make the Cake

You...SHOULD HAVE MADE

21. *I bet* she got the job

She ...MUST HAVE GOT

22. *Maybe* they suggested that

They...MAY/MIGHT/COULD HAVE SUGGESTED.....

23. *There's no way* she did that!

She...CAN'T HAVE DONE THAT
