Peter Rabbit is an **animated film based on the same book** by Beatrix Potter. **It was directed by** Will Gluck and released in March 2018. Talk show host, James Corden, gives voice to the fun-loving, trouble-making bunny. The film **stars** [Domhnall Gleeson](#) **who plays** Thomas McGregor, the new owner of the house and [Rose Byrne](#) **in the role of** [Bea](#), a woman who spends her time painting pictures of rabbits.

The plot is simple: when old Mr. McGregor dies, Peter (**the main character**) and his animal friends take over the house and garden which the old man kept locked up. However, McGregor’s grand nephew ,Thomas, soon moves in when he inherits the property. A battle arises between man and rabbit not only over the control of the garden but also for the affections of McGregor’s friendly neighbour, Bea

Generally speaking, the **movie is** quite silly and not always balanced. At the same time, it’s so warm, fuzzy and lively that most people will **be charmed** by it.

It is clear that Peter Rabbit’s **target audience** is children, and they’re going to love this. No kid can resist these cute animals jumping around, dancing, trashing a house and singing, especially because the **animation is really impressive** .Anyone who has kids around **should go see it** but if not, **give it a miss!** (= no vayas)
