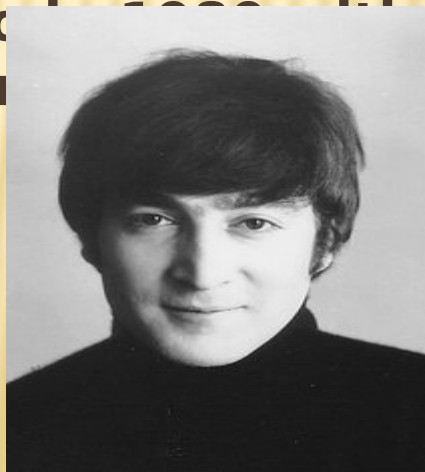


THE BEATLES

The Beatles were an English rock band formed in Liverpool in 1960. With members John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr, they became widely regarded as the foremost and most influential act of the rock era. Rooted in skiffle, beat and 1950s rock and roll, the Beatles later experimented with several musical styles, ranging from pop ballads and Indian music to psychedelia and hard rock, often incorporating classical elements and unconventional recording techniques in innovative ways.

JOHN LENNON

- Was a multi-instrumentalist musician and British composer who rose to fame as one of the founding members of The Beatles. He was born and raised in Liverpool, where as a teenager he was immersed in the British skiffle boom, forming the band The Quarrymen, that later in 1960 would become The Beatles.
- After marrying Yoko Ono in 1969, he changed his name to John Ono Lennon. Lennon retired from the music scene in 1975 to raise his young son Sean, but resurfaced with Ono in 1970 with the new album *Double Fantasy*. He was murdered seven weeks after its launch.



PAUL MCCARTNEY

- James Paul McCartney (Liverpool, June 18, 1942) is a British songwriter, multi-instrumentalist, and bass player. Along with John Lennon, George Harrison and Ringo Starr, gained worldwide fame for being the bass player of the rock band The Beatles, recognized as the most popular and influential in the history of popular music. After separation from the band, he continued his solo career and formed Wings with his first wife, Linda, and Denny Laine. McCartney has been recognized as one of the most successful composers and artists of all time, with 13 gold records and surpassing 100,000,000 records and 100,000,000 singles sold



GEORGE HARRISON

- George Harold Harrison (Liverpool, February 25, 1943- Los Angeles, November 29, 2001) was a multi-instrumentalist musician, songwriter, singer, music producer and British film producer, guitarist for The Beatles. Although John Lennon and Paul McCartney were the lead composers within the group, Harrison also included his own compositions on The Beatles records, such as "While My Guitar Gently Weeps", "Something" and "Here Comes the Sun". Harrison married twice, with Pattie Boyd, whom she divorced in 1977, and with Olivia Trinidad Arias, with whom she had only son, Dhani. In November 2001, Harrison died at the age of 58 after suffering lung cancer, and his ashes were scattered at a private ceremony on the Gangasutop river.



RINGO STARR

- Richard Starkey (Liverpool, Inglaterra, 7 de julio de 1940), más conocido como Ringo Starr, es un músico, cantante, compositor y actor británico que fue el baterista de la banda The Beatles. Antes de formar parte de The Beatles, Starr fue miembro de otra banda de Liverpool, Rory Storm & The Hurricanes. En agosto de 1962, Pete Best fue despedido y Ringo ocupó su lugar, cambiando así mismo el nombre de la banda de "The Silver Beatles" por el oficial, "The Beatles". Además de tocar la batería, Starr participó como vocalista en varias canciones versadas por el grupo como «With a Little Help from My Friends», «Yellow Submarine», «Act Naturally» y «I Wanna Be Like You» entre otras y fue el compositor de las canciones «You're a Good Boy, Blue Boy», «Pass Me By» y «Octopus's Garden».
