

## USOS DE SOME/ANY

### Diferencia entre *some* y *any*

Estas dos palabras que nos causan tantos problemas son cuantificadores. Es decir, nos cuantifican en cierto modo la cantidad de un sustantivo. Sin embargo, el problema surge porque no sabemos cuándo usar *some* o cuándo usar *any*, ya que ambas se utilizan cuando no especificamos una cantidad exacta. Veamos un par de ejemplos:

*I'm having some friends over tomorrow night. (Vienen algunos amigos a mi casa mañana noche.)*

*Are there any pupils in the class? (¿Hay algún alumno/algunos alumnos en la clase?)*

En ciertos casos, como en los ejemplos, tanto *some* como *any* pueden traducirse por «algunos» o «algún». ¿Pero cuándo utilizamos uno u otro exactamente?

### 1. Cuándo utilizar *some*

En general utilizamos *some* en oraciones positivas con sustantivos plurales o incontables. Por ejemplo:

*She's had some problems with the teacher. (problems = sustantivo contable plural)*

*I got some money from my parents. (money = sustantivo incontable)*

### 2. Cuándo utilizar *any*

Lo más común es utilizar *any* en oraciones negativas o interrogativas con sustantivos plurales o incontables. Por ejemplo:

*John hasn't got any books in his bedroom. (books = sustantivo contable plural)*

*Is there any sugar left? (sugar = sustantivo incontable)*
