



MY GRANDMOTHER

My grandmother's name is Dolores Caride Otero but she likes to be called lola.

She was born on September 18, 1941, in Vigo, Cabral, but when she was two years old she went to live in Lavadores.



His parents were named José and Virgilia.

She studied in two schools. The first years in a public one and then in a private one until the age of 13, since in those days you could leave earlier.

She started working at the age of 16 in a rubber shoe factory until she was 20.



At the age of 19, she met her husband, Jesús Castro, and left her job to marry him at the age of 20 in the parish church of Santa Cristina.
