
## Érika Rodríguez Alonso 1º Bach D

At the age of 21 she had her first son José Manuel Alonso Álvarez. As a result, my grandparents rented a flat in Calle Colombia, Vigo.


At the age of 23 she had my mother Paula Alonso Álvarez.

At that age he also had to move out of the flat because the owners were going to occupy it, so they returned to Corujo.




My grandparents and their children lived for years in Corujo until they bought a flat in Lavadores, Vigo.

And she started working at Marodri Cleaning.






At the age of 34 she had her youngest son, lago Alonso Álvarez. That same year she joined the Xunta de Galicia's labour staff.
