

THEORY:

How to Write an Informative Essay.

The informative must impart knowledge about a specific topic. So, its main purpose is inform the reader, that means that the writer has to give many details, clarify definitions or terms and provide meaningful explanations.

You mustn't write your opinion, but you must explain the process in which an event, a situation or the circumstances of life of a person.

You must use a Cause & Effect structure. This implies that you must use the connectors of cause and effect or those of cause and result.

Some Steps to Write an Informative Essay.

- Focus on the topic proposed by the teacher, or the book.
- Create the structure that will organize your facts in a logical order.
- Gather all the necessary information for the work from different sources.
- The Introduction / Opening must present the topic (definition, historic background and the manner in which the problem or the origin of the subject was introduced.)
- The Body / Development must include facts and provide them with detail, that means, including ideas and examples of the manner in which the topic was developed (General information, comparison with another idea related to the topic, as well as the advantages and disadvantages)
- The Conclusion / Closing must summarize the topic and include a recommendation.
- Revise all the work done.
