THEORY: CONFUSING WORDS: SPECIALLY & ESPECIALLY

Especially is used to say that something applies more to one thing than to others. **Specially** is used to say that something is done for a particular purpose.

Before adjectives it's better to use **especially** to emphasize them. For example, *especially good* (but not *specially good*).

Especially cannot be used at the beginning of a sentence. She loves vegetables. *She especially likes carrots* (but not *Especially she likes carrots*).

Examples:

1. Especially (= Mainly)

We should practice more, especially grammar.

2. Specially (= In a special manner)

This mouse is specially designed for left-handed people.
