THEORY: THE PRONUNCIATION OF THE -S ENDING.

We observe this ending for the plurals of the nouns and for the third person singular of the Present Simple.

The -s ending may be pronounced in three different manners:

1. / s /
2. / z /
3. / iz /

These pronunciations depend on the consonant that precedes the -s ending.

These are the rules of use :

/ s /	/ z /	/ iz /
-P SHOP, SLEEP	-D DEMAND	-CE RACE, REDUCE
-K BOOK, WORK	-G BEG	-CH WATCH, REACH
-F CLIFF, LAUGH	-L FEEL	-S BUS, INCREASE
-TH TOOTH, SCATHE	-M PERFORM	-X BOX, WAX
	-N PHONE	-Z PRIZE, USE, BUZZ
	-NG SING	-SS BOSS, KISS
	-R WEAR	-SH DISH, WASH
	-V LOVE	-GE CHANGE
	-Y PLAY
