THEORY : REPORTED SPEECH WITH DIFFERENT TYPES OF SENTENCES

Study the chart about the Reported Speech.

THE REPORTED SPEECH
STATEMENT
Examples: - Direct speech: "Volunteers cleaned the beach yesterday," said John. - Indirect Speech: He said that volunteers had cleaned the beach the day before.
YES/NO QUESTION
Examples: - Direct speech: "Are they working now?" he asked. - Indirect Speech: He asked if / whether they were working then.
WH- QUESTION
Examples: - Direct speech: "What can we do to help?" they asked. - Indirect Speech: They asked what they could do to help.
ORDER
Examples: - Direct speech: "Take your rubbish with you," he said. (Affirmative) - Indirect Speech: He said us to take our rubbish with us. - Direct speech: "Don't dump the waste here!" he said. (Negative) - Indirect Speech: He told us not to dump the waste there.
REQUEST & Kind Petition)
Examples: - Direct speech: "Please give us a talk about solar energy," she said. - Indirect Speech: She asked me to give them a talk about solar energy.
OFFER
Examples: - Direct speech: "I'll explain this to you," Greg said. - Indirect Speech: Greg offered to explain that to me.
SUGGESTION
Examples: - Direct speech: "Let's do a project," said Lynn. - Indirect Speech: Lynn suggested doing / that we do a project.
