

In groups of 3 to 4 people decide if you prefer doing an infographic about Halloween celebrations, history and traditions in Great Britain and the USA; or if on the contrary you prefer doing it about Halloween celebrations, history and traditions all around the world (In this case, compare at least 3 countries).

- Use the Internet to find information.
- Take notes about the information.
- Choose graphics, graphs or a combination of these (bar charts, bubble graphs, line graphs, pie charts, pyramid charts,...) which you could use to present the information in your project.
- You can develop the project using any App you consider necessary to do so.
- You should upload your projects to AULA VIRTUAL. Your projects should be done by all the members in the group.

You should include information about:

- Halloween history / facts.
- Halloween symbols / icons.
- the average number of people who celebrate it.
- the most important traditions in each place.
- the money spend on decorations, costumes, ...
- the costumes preferred by people.
 or any other important info you can think of when Halloween comes to your mind.

You will be positively assessed in case you:

- are creative and original.
- use your own words. Do not copy literal information.
- respect the deadline (Thursday 2nd of November 2023)
- are able to work as part of a group and collaborate to reach your goal: the infographic.
- are able to transmit as much information as possible in your infographic in a clear way (using graphs, graphics or any other visual content, instead of only writing long pieces of texts). Show the info as briefly and clearly as possible.
