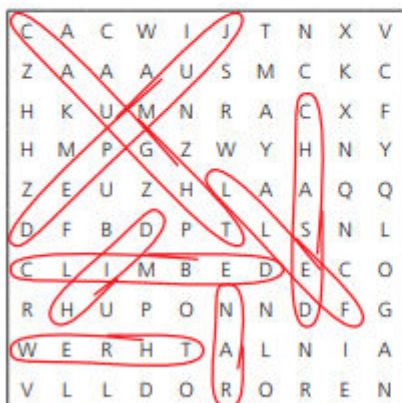

MUST

Must es un verbo modal igual que **can**, etc. Esto significa que normalmente requieren otro verbo para completar el significado:

We must study for the chemistry test

Nosotros debemos estudiar para el examen de química

Como se ve en el ejemplo, el verbo que está a continuación de **must**, se encuentra en la forma de **infinitivo sin to**.

Como al resto de los verbos modales, al verbo **"must"** **no** se le añade una "-s" en la tercera persona del singular.

Conjugación	Significado
I must study	yo debo estudiar
you must study	tú debes estudiar
He/she must study	Él/ella debe estudiar
we must study	nosotros debemos estudiar
you must study	vosotros debéis estudiar
they must study	ellos deben estudiar

La **negación** se forma con el adverbio **"not"**:

You must not go out at night = You mustn't go out at night

(No debes salir por las noches)

- **En afirmativa indica obligación y en negativa indica prohibición**

SHOULD

Should es otro verbo modal igual que **can**, **must** etc. Esto significa que normalmente requieren otro verbo para completar el significado:

We should study for the chemistry test

Nosotros deberíamos estudiar para el examen de química

Como se ve en el ejemplo, el verbo que está a continuación de **should**, se encuentra en la forma de **infinitivo sin to**.

Como al resto de los verbos modales, al verbo **"should"** **no** se le añade una "-s" en la tercera persona del singular.

Conjugación	Significado
I should study	yo debería estudiar
you should study	tú deberías estudiar
He/she should study	Él/ella debería estudiar
we should study	nosotros deberíamos estudiar
you should study	vosotros deberíais estudiar
they should study	ellos deberían estudiar

La **negación** se forma con el adverbio **"not"**:

You should not go out at night = You shouldn't go out at night

(No deberías salir por las noches)
