1	What is the Burning Man festival?	It's an arts community festival. It takes place for a week at the end of August every year in the Black Rock Desert in Nevada, USA. More than 60,000 people went last year. Volunteers create a community in the desert called Black Rock City. They build everything themselves. The city is in the shape of a giant semi-circle.
2	Has the festival always taken place there?	No, it started in San Francisco, California in 1986 next to the Golden Gate Bridge. It moved to the desert five years later.
3	Why is it called the Burning Man?	Because fire is an important theme of the festival. People build an enormous wooden effigy* of a person. It's more than 30 metres tall and made of wood. They also build and burn lots of other things. Last year, they had an enormous mechanical octopus! *effigy – a sculpture of a person, often made of wood or straw
4	What else do people do at the festival?	They dress up in crazy costumes and wear goggles and masks because of the dust in the desert. And there are a lot of other fun activities. There is usually a balloon chain of 450 different balloons. The chain is one kilometre long and lights up the sky.
5	How is it different to other festivals?	It's unusual because there aren't any famous bands or celebrities. It's all about community – everyone is on the same level.
6	Does the festival have any rules?	There's one very strict rule: after the festival, people must take everything away with them and leave the desert exactly as it was before the festival started. The organisers are very worried about the environment.
