WHAT IS MIGRATION?

Migration is a movement, permanent or temporary, of groups from one territory to another, from one location to another, determined by various reasons, but essentially by necessities of life.



In addition to Spaniards returning to the country, some of the foreigners who obtained Spanish nationality in previous years have also returned to Spain. They are mainly people from Latin America, and in particular from Venezuela.

Among the foreigners who arrived in Spain in 2017, the main nationalities are Moroccan, Colombian and Venezuelan. The regions with the highest migratory influx were Madrid and Catalonia.

The latest data on the resident population in Spain in 2017 is 46,659,302 people registered.

WHAT GUYS THINKS MIGRATION?

Most of the guys come from Latin America. Arrived in Spain at an early age, they did not experience any problems with the language.

Migration is seen as an opportunity to improve life expectancy, unite different ethnic groups and cultures . Most people migrate to find work and study, although many others migrate without finding better living conditions.
