The name *Jamiroquai* is a conglomeration of the word "jam" and the name of the Native American people, the Iroquois. Jamiroquai's lead singer, Jason Kay, says that this name grew out of his admiration of the culture of the Iroquois. The band started in 1993, when Jason Kay signed an eight-album deal with Sony. Over twenty million albums, five MTV awards and a Grammy later, Jay Kay has become an international music icon. The album "Travelling Without Moving" which includes the song "Virtual Insanity", made Jamiroquai global. This album came with a prophetic warning of the dangers of biogenetic engineering.
