#### Formato

## Parte 1

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### Texto

#### How to get a business class bargain: The tricks to finding luxury travel at the cheapest price

For most of us, turning left while boarding and settling down to unlimited champagne and a lie-flat seat is something we can only dream of. But fares for business class seats have dropped significantly in recent years as airlines struggle to fill their luxurious cabins.

Pre-pandemic, the smartest cabins were taken up predominantly by those flying for work, but as companies stopped sending executives overseas for meetings, airlines began reducing prices to tempt leisure travellers. Seats in business class cabins from April to December this year are 10 per cent lower than in 2022. Demand for business class seats was high after the pandemic so airlines were able to demand high prices, but from the start of 2023 demand dropped, meaning airlines having to fight to win over customers.

#### How to secure the very best business class deals on an economy budget?

Many airlines allow travellers with seats booked in economy **to bid online for a business upgrade**. Online bidding opens two to seven days before a flight and close about five hours before it. Travellers submit an online bid and if successfully upgraded, they are entitled to all the perks and benefits of the new travel class.

If you're happy to **change planes** you can make big savings. And if you're willing to accept a lengthy stopover or an overnight stay, there are bigger reductions still.

For the cheapest fares, it's important **when you book**. For economy domestic flights, the cheapest time to book is five months before departure but when it comes to business class, the further you can book in advance, the better the prices as Corporate travellers tend to book three-four weeks before travel, so if you book during this time then you'll be paying these inflated prices.

**Error fares** are pricing mistakes made online by either an airline or travel agency. These fares have to be honoured by airlines once purchased, but are often only available for an hour or two before they're spotted by the airlines and removed.

Finally, you can **set up alerts** using Google Flights which will track prices for particular routes and email you when prices significantly increase or decrease.
